

SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS FOR 2010

Before the start and after the end of fishing it is necessary to inform the fish guard on duty in the fishermen's hut on the lake

Fishing is only allowed (should there be a low water level – in front) from the marked fishing positions except for those fishermen who use the “fish hook on the buoy” technique.

Obligatory possession and usage of a large bucket for fish and an original carpet, which has been previously moistened, for depositing fish

Use of any kind of vessel is not allowed and entrance in the water is only allowed during fish fatiguing (drilling) and placing fish into the bucket

Only the permitted catch may be kept in the keeper's net

Entrance with vehicles to the lake gate is not permitted

The lighting of fires inside the lake's gate is not allowed as well as in any other part of the lake area from 1st July until the 1st October

It is not permitted to leave behind any kind of waste and every fisherman is obliged after fishing, to leave his fishing position in a clean and orderly fashion.

During sports fishing fishermen are not allowed to leave their fishing positions nor to leave thrown sticks in the water.

It is obligatory to throw the following catches back into the water: carp of 4 kg and over, amur of 6 kg and over and the pikeperch of 3 kg and under

From 1st March until 31st May it is forbidden to use live or dead small fish as bait

The permitted annual/daily fish catch for fishermen who have an annual national licence: carp-8 pieces (2 per day), amur-5 pieces (1 per day), pikeperch-8 pieces (2 per day), sheat-fish - 8 pieces (2 per day) and an unlimited quantity of any other fish species.

Permitted catch for those fishermen who have national daily licence: carp or amur – 1 piece, pikeperch – 2 pieces, sheat-fish – 1 piece. and an unlimited quantity of other fish species

Whilst buying the annual national licence fishermen are obligatory to pay 200.00 KN into the fund for stocking and fishermen who are buying daily national licences are obligatory to pay 40.00 KN in fund for ecology.

For those purchasing an annual national licence, it is obligatory, to carry out two activities or to pay an amount of 200.00 KN for every undone work activity during the entire year.

The above mentioned special restrictions are founded on an economic basis, an annual plan and in accordance with article 22, subsection 2 of the Law on freshwater fishing.

Violation of these regulations will be sanctioned by further banning of sports fishing in Tribalj Lake.
